TERMS & CONDITIONS, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY, AND INDEMNIFICATION

Terms & Conditions

These Terms and Conditions govern participation in the MicDrop Nation Nashville (the “Program”), operated by MicDrop Nation, LLC, doing business as MicDrop Nation Nashville (“MicDrop Nation”). By enrolling in or participating in the Program, the participant, or the parent/legal guardian of a minor participant, agrees to all terms set forth herein.

Participation in the Program includes engagement in a performance-based educational experience that may involve vocal instruction, acting and performance training, rehearsals, workshops, live performances, studio sessions, group activities, lodging accommodations, meals, transportation to and from Program-related activities, and the use of third-party venues and facilities. Participation is voluntary and undertaken with full understanding of the nature of the activities involved.

MicDrop Nation operates as an independent organization and is not affiliated with, endorsed by, or controlled by any third-party venues, institutions, or service providers utilized in connection with the Program. This includes, but is not limited to, the Troubadour Theater, Cumberland University or any university housing provider, hotels, transportation companies, recording studios, or any other venues or facilities used during the Program.

Participation in the Program involves inherent risks, both known and unknown, including but not limited to physical injury, illness, exposure to communicable diseases, emotional stress, performance-related anxiety, accidents during activities or transportation, and loss or damage to personal property. All such risks are voluntarily assumed to the fullest extent permitted by law.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, MicDrop Nation, MicDrop Nation Nashville, LLC, and all associated parties shall not be liable for any claims, demands, damages, injuries, losses, or causes of action arising out of or related to participation in the Program. This limitation of liability applies to any claims based on ordinary negligence and includes, without limitation, personal injury, illness, emotional distress, property damage, or loss.

This release of liability extends to and includes all owners, officers, directors, employees, instructors, coaches, judges, guest artists, staff members, volunteers, drivers, transportation providers, independent contractors, vendors, partner organizations, affiliates, and any third-party venues or facilities associated with the Program, including but not limited to the Troubadour Theater, Cumberland University or any housing provider, hotels, rehearsal spaces, studios, and event locations.

The participant, or parent/legal guardian of a minor participant, agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless MicDrop Nation and all associated parties from and against any and all claims, liabilities, damages, losses, costs, or expenses, including reasonable attorney’s fees, arising out of or related to participation in the Program, any violation of Program policies, or any act or omission that results in injury to persons or damage to property.

Medical

Participants are required to be physically and emotionally capable of participating in all Program activities. MicDrop Nation does not provide medical insurance, and all medical expenses incurred as a result of participation are the sole responsibility of the participant or their parent/legal guardian. In the event of an emergency, MicDrop Nation reserves the right to seek medical treatment on behalf of the participant, and all associated costs shall remain the responsibility of the participant or parent/legal guardian.

Transportation

The Program may include transportation via vehicles operated by staff members or third-party providers. All risks associated with transportation are assumed, and MicDrop Nation shall not be held liable for incidents occurring during travel to, from, or within Program activities.

Behavior

Participants are expected to comply with all Program rules, policies, and instructions provided by MicDrop Nation staff. This includes adherence to behavioral expectations, professional conduct standards, and dress guidelines appropriate for a performance and industry-based environment. MicDrop Nation reserves the right to remove any participant from the Program, without refund, for conduct deemed unsafe, disruptive, inappropriate, or non-compliant with Program standards.

Property

MicDrop Nation is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property. Participants are solely responsible for the security and care of their belongings throughout the duration of the Program.

Payments

All payments made toward the Program are subject to the stated payment terms and conditions. Deposits may be non-refundable, and refunds may not be issued for voluntary withdrawal, dismissal due to misconduct, or failure to participate. MicDrop Nation reserves the right to make changes to Program schedules, instructors, locations, or activities as necessary without prior notice.

Photo Release

MicDrop Nation reserves the right to photograph, record, and use image, voice, and performance of participants for promotional, educational, and marketing purposes in any media format without compensation, unless otherwise prohibited by law.

These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Tennessee. Any disputes arising under or related to these Terms shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the appropriate courts within the State of Tennessee.
