Dress Standards & Professional Appearance

MicDrop Nation is a professional, industry-facing experience. Student-Artists are expected to dress in a manner that reflects professionalism, respect, and readiness for opportunity. Nashville is a relationship-driven industry, and participants should dress as if they may meet an industry professional at any time.

Clothing must be modest and appropriate. Prohibited attire includes spaghetti straps, visible bras or undergarments, crop tops, excessively low-cut tops, booty shorts, tight or revealing leggings, or sheer clothing. Dresses and skirts must be no shorter than just above the knee.

Comfortable attire is appropriate for workshops, rehearsals, and conference-style sessions. When attending performances, industry meetings, studio visits, or outings such as the Grand Ole Opry, Student-Artists are expected to present their best professional appearance in both clothing and attitude.
